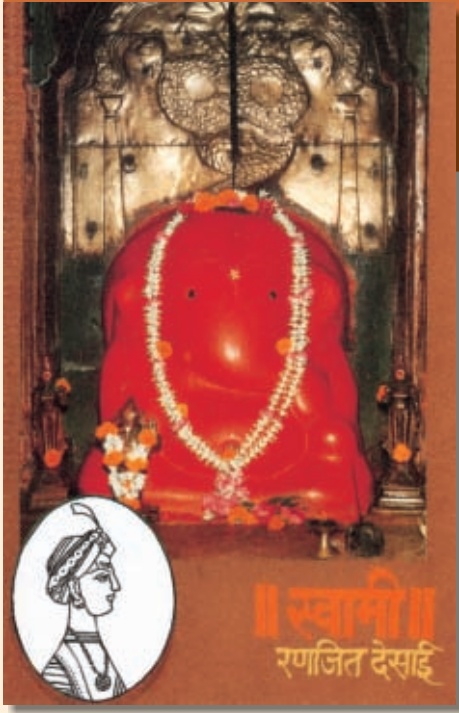

The Maratha (non Muslim) empire established in Maharashtra by Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj (d. 1680) against all odds later passed into the hands of the Peshwas (prime minister) who became the supreme lords. The Maratha Empire which stretched across a sizeable portion of Western, Central and Northern India suffered a severe setback when the Marathas lost the (Third) Battle of Panipat in 1761. It was an immense loss of men, money, and material. The then Peshwa Nanasaheb could not bear the brunt of the casualties which included his eldest son and younger brother, and soon passed away. For the sixteen year old Madhavrao who succeeded Nanasaheb, it was not a piece of cake. The coffers were empty, the royal court was fraught with internal dissensions. Swami is based on the life and character of Madhavrao who resurrected the Maratha empire. He revived the lost glory and pride. The extent of the empire was now wider than before. He contained the enemy. Swami sketches the personal life of the Peshwa and specially poignant are the parts covering the discomfort he feels when Raghunathrao is a thorn in his flesh, and his untimely death. The novel throws light on the political, social and cultural history of the mid Peshwa era.

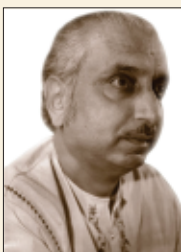


# SHRIMANYOGI

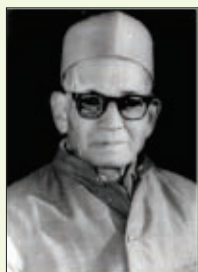

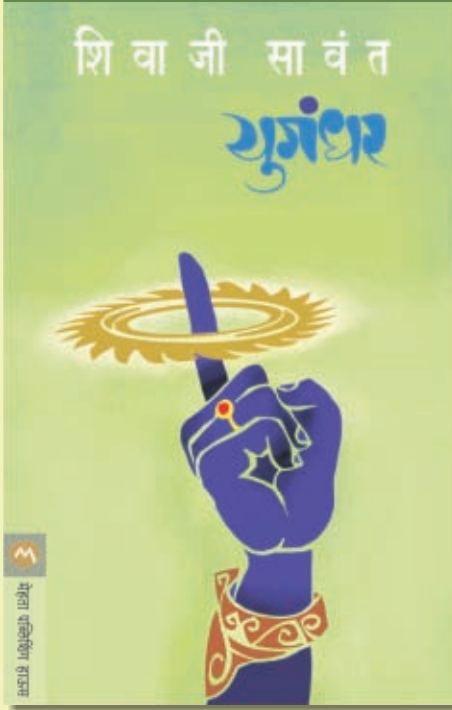

## SAMBHAJI

**Chhatrapati Sambhaji (1657-1689)** was the son of **Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj**. His

life is full of ups and downs. He lost his mother when he was a child. He was held as a prisoner with his father at Agra, was in prison and denied ascension to the throne when his father passed away. But he turned tables on those who denied it and was crowned as a Chhatrapati in 1680. He set out on a military expedition within a fortnight after his coronation and in the years to come fought battles against the Mughals who were led by Aurangzeb; the Siddis (Abyssinians) who ruled Janjira in coastal Maharashtra; the Portuguese in Goa; and Mysore. He was captured and brutally executed by Aurangzeb. On the home front, his kingdom was torn by strife for which he was partly responsible. The discord also led to his downfall to some extent.

Chhatrapati Sambhaji is often portrayed as an unworthy son of a great king. Sambhaji will put all allegations and prejudice to rest.

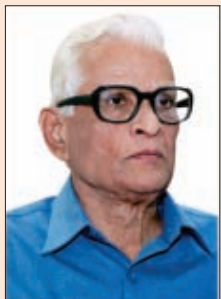

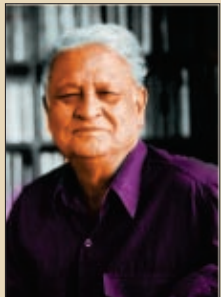

## KARUNASHTAK

**Karunashtaka**, renders a story of the author's mother, a woman from a middle class Brahmin family which lives in penury in rural Maharashtra. It is a large family: an old lady, the father whose earnings are meager, the mother, and eight children. The parents are unable to bring up all children and often take to sending some to either a home of charity or to other relatives. The abject poverty is worsened when the family is crushed under debt and sources of income dwindle. The family had also to bear the brunt of public anger following the assassination of **Mahatma Gandhi** by a Brahmin. While conditions improve as more members begin to earn, the woman now sees her husband and many of her children pass away. She puts up with the tragedy bravely but is dispirited from within.

**Karunashtaka** may be seen as a form of an autobiographical novel. Thus it reflects a section of the society in twentieth century India, which lived in stringent conditions. One may also see in it the story of a mother anywhere at any time in the world, who faces similar hardships while raising her little ones.

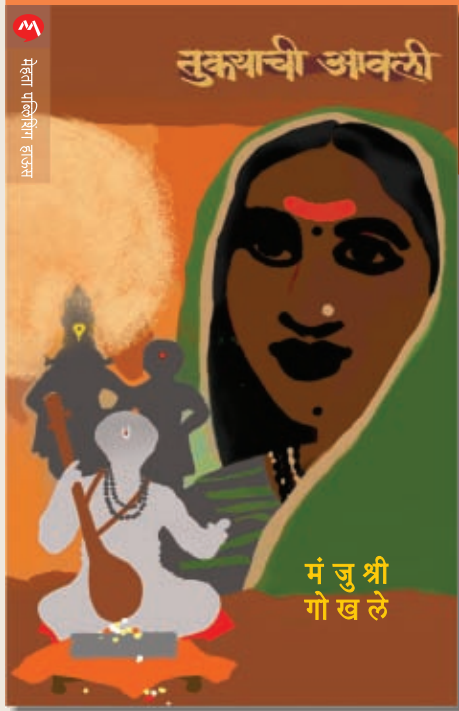

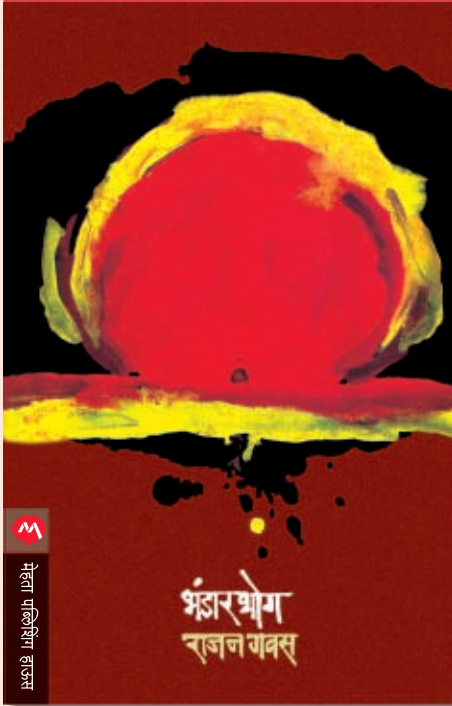


**Manjushri Gokhale** (21 November, 1957)

Yellama is a Goddess which has a large following in Maharashtra. The cult of Yeallama has a tradition (now out laws) of in which a boy or a girl is offered to the Goddess. After being inducted into the cult through an elaborate process the boy (jogatee) or the girl (jogateen) take to propogating virtues of the Goddess and to seeking alms (jogva) in the village. At times, a jogtee may dress like a female to symbolize the sons of the Goddess, who became impotent. In such cases they become objects of ridicule. The life of a jogatee does not become ridiculous only due to cross dressing: he is subject to several unjust social restrictions. The life of a jogateen is no better: she can be an object of sexual exploitation.

Turmeric powder plays an important role in the life of a jogatee The title Bhandarbhog made up of two words, Bhandara (a form of turmeric) and bhog (fruit of good and bad experiences), aptly traces the tragic story of Tayappa, who is forced to become a jogatee. He lives almost as an outcaste or an untouchable. The novel brings out effectively the life of a small world of socially condemned people.



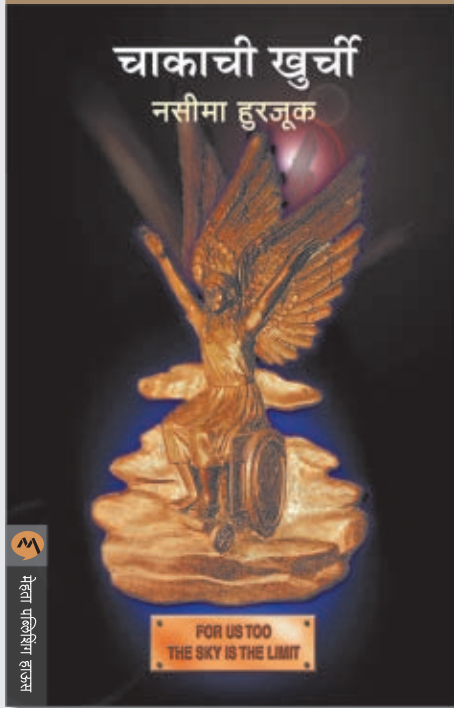
Rajan Gavas (1 June, 1959)

As a teenager, Naseema Hurjuk was active in sports and cultural activities. She was later struck with paraplegia when she was sixteen: she lost use of the lower half of her body.. To add to the physical discomfort was the trauma of sudden death of her father, Though she became wheelchair bound, Naseema drew inspiration and motivation from the life of Shri Babu Kaka Diwan who too in spite of being a paraplegic was highly mobile. She completed her graduation and got employment in a Government Department. She participated in the 'Stock Mandville Games' for the handicapped held in London in 1973. Later resigning from the job, Naseema jointly founded an organisation called Helpers of the Handicapped. '**Helpers**' aims at making medical treatment accessible and affordable, also to rehabilitate physically challenged people in the society, given their special needs and abilities. Physically challenged persons are taught that handicap is not a limitation. They are provided integrated facilities) to get over the handicap and live their lives with dignity and independence. Chakachee Khurchee is the account of the life and the work of Naseema Hurjuk. Life had never been easy to her and her way in leading the physically handicapped, mostly paraplegics, was also not a bed of roses.

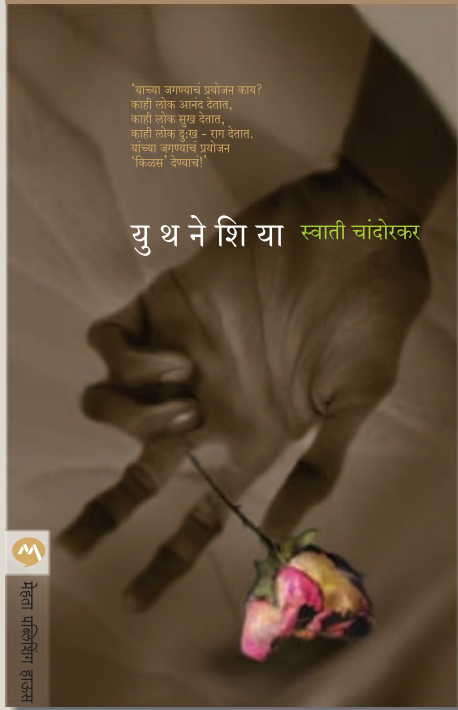
